MBC is a religious camp and as such the goals and aims of the program are in accordance with the New Testament teachings of the Holy Bible and doctrines of the Southern Baptist Convention. You will be asked about your personal life style and your spiritual beliefs in the personal interview. According to the policies of the camp we will request a police file on each applicant. If you have a police record and would like to explain the situation, please check the box here and include the explanation on a separate sheet. **Confidentiality is assured.**

Because of your strong influence on campers as a camp staffer, it is of utmost importance that your conduct both at camp and when away from the campus demonstrates your Christian walk. Therefore we attempt to hire staffs that are mature both emotionally and spiritually. There are guidelines and regulations, which we have set down as requirements for attitude and action while on staff at MBC. Personal hygiene, habits, grooming, language, and attitude are all a part of the responsibility of a good staffer.
